Attendance/Absences

Attendance is one of our key focus areas and as such we would like to remind parents to please notify the school if your child is going to be absent for any reason as soon as possible.

Active After School Sport

The Active After School Sport program is run every Tuesday after school from 3.00pm – 4.15pm. The program offers 60 minutes of physical activity which is fun and safe. Any student who behaves in an inappropriate manner will be given a warning, and then, if the inappropriate behaviour continues, will be sent home. That student may also be denied access to the program for a period of time decided upon by the Active After School deliverers and the Principal or Teacher-in-charge at the time. Inappropriate behaviour includes swearing, rudeness, continual disobeying of instructions, bullying of other students either physically or verbally.

All permission notes need to be returned.....no permission note/no participation.

After School Sport sessions this term will involve water-based activities. All children must return their permission notes before they will be allowed in the pool. All children must have clean swimmers and a towel for these sessions.

INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOUR WILL NOT BE TOLERATED IN THE POOL. CHILDREN WHO DO NOT FOLLOW THE RULES WILL BE BANNED FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE TERM.


