We finally started swimming and we love it. We are already making great progress and becoming more confident in the water.



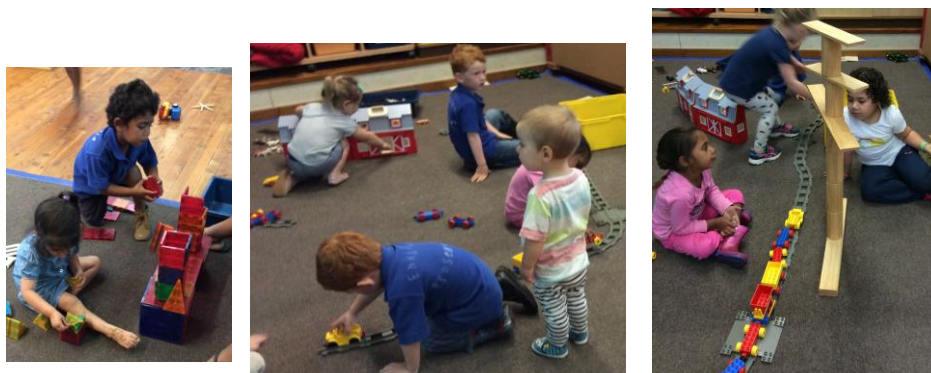
We have a new wooden barn and we love to play with it. We organise it with lots of animals and put other animals in the paddock.



We also have a new cement mixer to play with in the sand pit. We love exploring the sand and mixing it with water.

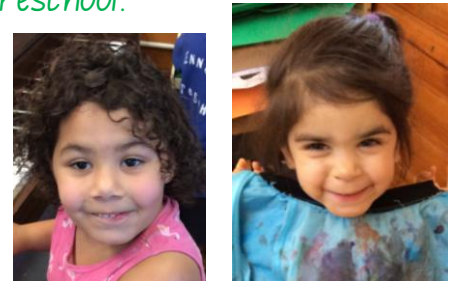


We have been busy exploring with the train set and blocks. We love pushing the train and feeling it move smoothly along the train track.
