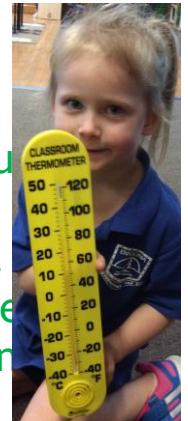
### Preschool
