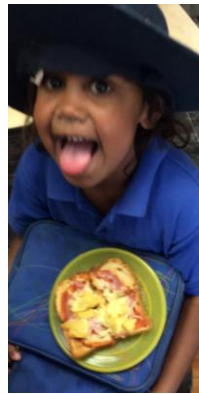

Have we mentioned that we love swimming 😊. We have been practising our floating skills. Each week we are becoming more confident swimmers.



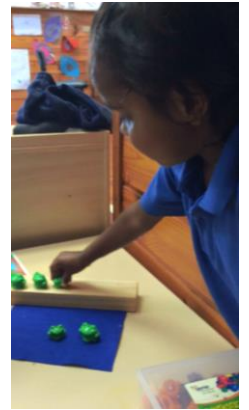
Flying a Kite
