PRESCHOOL NEWS

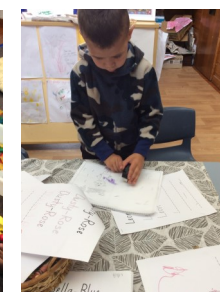
